The authors regret to inform you that we want to make two corrections in the paper mentioned-above. **First, in Fig. 2**, we want to replace the phrases “Source: Compiled by the authors, 2018” by the phrases “Adapted from Spangenberg and Valentin, 1999 cited in Cottrell et al., 2013” **Second, in Table 4**, the values included in the column representing “**composite scores**” were miscalculated. The

correct values are 0.795 for economic sustainability, 0.793 for environmental sustainability, 0.885 for socio-cultural sustainability, and 0.904 for institutional sustainability. We need the values of 0.962, 0.939, 0.978, and 0.972 get removed. The authors would like to apologise for any inconvenience caused.
